



Terms and Conditions

- A non-refundable deposit of £50 is required at time of booking.
- All original digital images remain the property of Barry Young Photography.
- All albums, canvases, reprints and enlargements will be at the price current at the time of ordering.
- As colour photography is undertaken within the technical limitations of the process, exact colour matching cannot be guaranteed.
- Customers who cancel our services more than six months prior to their wedding can use their deposit towards another future booking for wedding, other celebration, or event photography.
- The photographer will honour all photographs requested and agreed in advance, provided the following factors are met: Weather and allocated time permitting, availability and co-operation of the person/s concerned.
- Every care is taken in photographing and processing using professional materials. In the unlikely event of total photographic failure, the Photographer's liability shall be limited to a full refund of all monies paid.
- Family and friends are encouraged to take photographs but you are asked to assist in ensuring that guests do not disturb, disrupt or interfere with the photographer's duties.
- Barry Young Photography cannot be held responsible for images and photography sessions being disrupted by adverse/unfavourable weather conditions.
- The 1988 Copyright Design & Patents Act - sect. 77 & 80 assigns the copyright of photographs/digital images to Barry Young Photography. It is contrary to the Act and an offence to copy or allow to be copied photographs/digital images captured by Barry Young Photography by any means unless written permission is granted by Barry Young Photography.
- All orders for albums, canvases, reprints and enlargements must be paid for at the time of ordering.
- Web galleries will be set up within 5 working days, and preview albums will be available within 12 working days of the wedding. The wedding album or wedding book will be available within 6 weeks of ordering.
